
Introduction

Classes transitioned from face-to-face to remote environments in March of 2020.

LCOT offers both ESL & HSE Classes



 Classes were composed of 5-20 students ranging from ages 17 - 83
 & a wide variety of ethnicities.

 Each class was delivered through Zoom for at least 40 minutes twice a week.

Solution:


