## **Team Teaching:** How to Jump Start Remote Classes

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Session Description: Are you concerned about transitioning your face to face classes to online remote classes? Remote learning has become the new normal, but that does not mean it is an easy transition for any teacher. In

## Introduction

### Literacy Council of Tyler

The Literacy Council of Tyler (LCOT) serves approximately 2400 students in the Tyler, TX area per year. Classes transitioned from face-to-face to remote environments in March of 2020.

### LCOT offers both ESL & HSE Classes

- Classes were composed of 5-20 students ranging from ages 17 - 83 & a wide variety of ethnicities.
- Each class was delivered through Zoom for at least 40 minutes twice a week.

### Literacy Council of Tyler Remote Classes

Challenges:

- Student & teacher technology
- Best practices

- Schedules
- Lack of experience

Solution:

Staff support and team teaching was implemented.

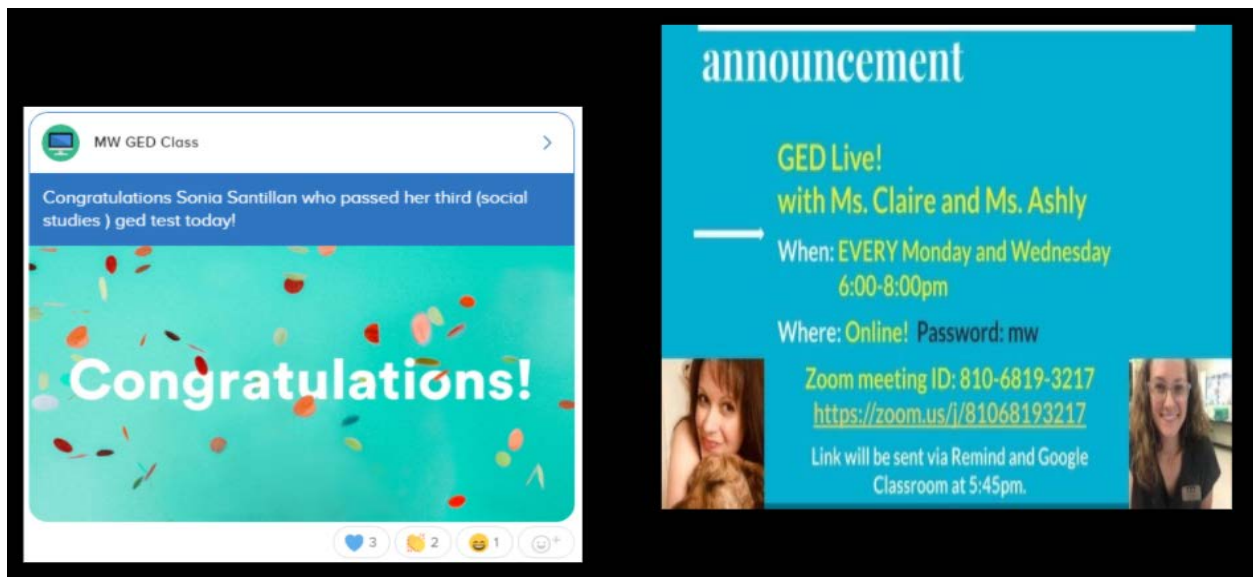

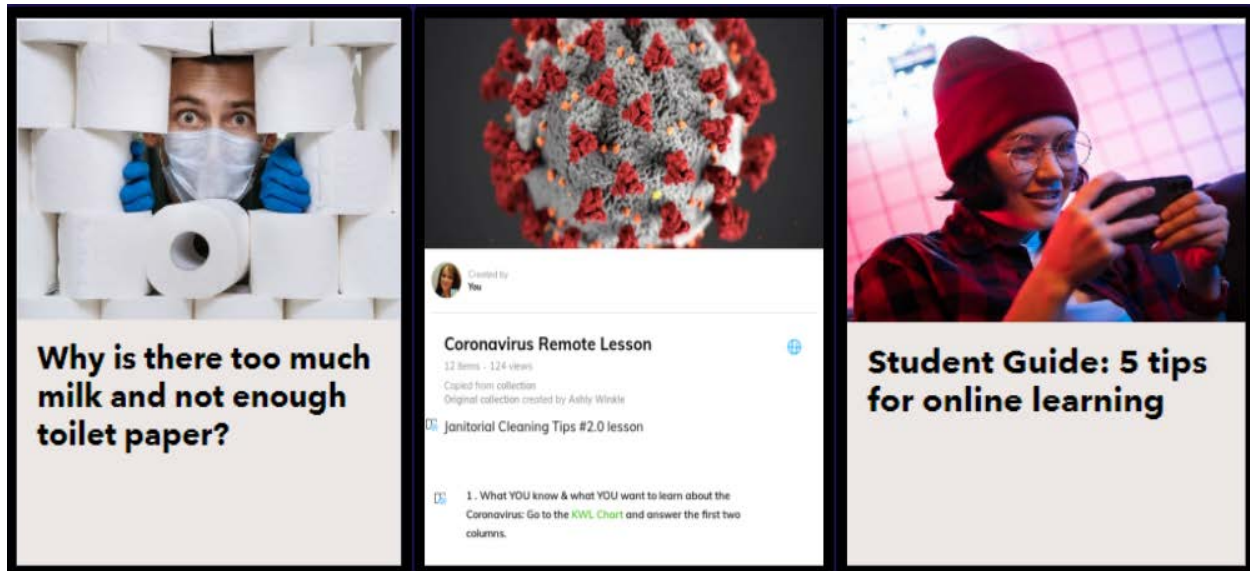


