






## **Examples of Best Practice Goals**

#### **Asynchronous Class**

- □ Use at least one new tool for communication, student engagement, building community, onboarding, etc.
- ☐ Increase # of direct meetings
- Incorporate digital citizenship activity into direct meetings

#### Remote/Virtual Class


- ☐ Integrate a new tool into online instruction
- ☐ Integrate a digital citizenship skills and/or digital literacy skills into class instruction
- ☐ Try a new tool for independent practice, game-based learning, or communication


## **Examples of Best Practice Goals**

# Hybrid and Blended Learning


- Start communicating MORE with these students
- Try new tools to help build community online and face to face
- Teach students digital literacy and/or digital citizenship skills
- Train teachers how to integrate a new tool

#### Distance Learning Best Practice Goal-Setting Activity


