

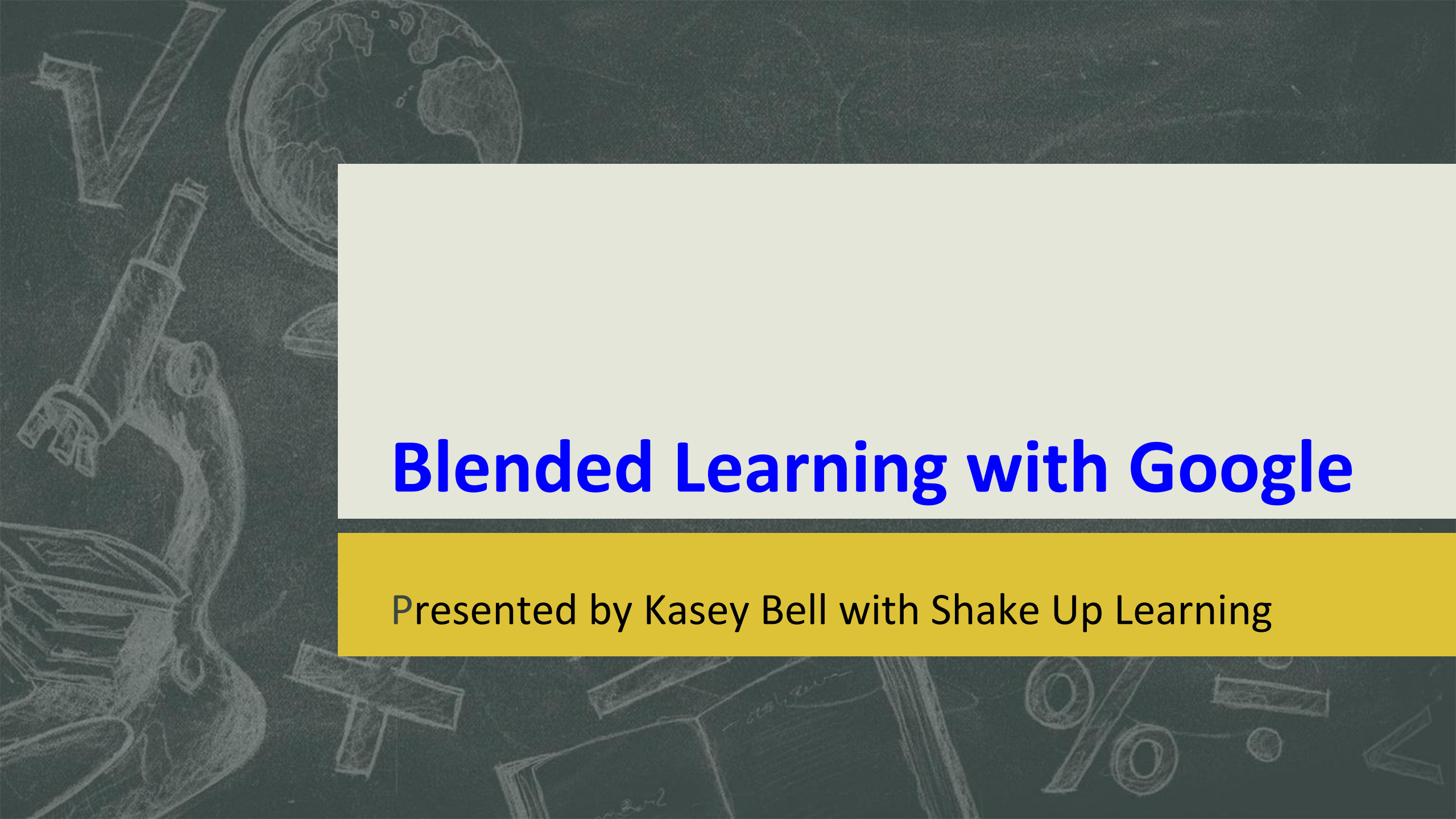

Examples of Best Practice Goals

Asynchronous Class

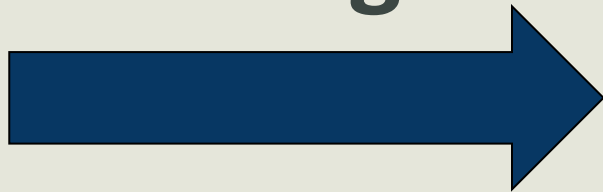
- ❑ Use at least one new tool for communication, student engagement, building community, onboarding, etc.
- ❑ Increase # of direct meetings
- ❑ Incorporate digital citizenship activity into direct meetings

Remote/Virtual Class

- ❑ Integrate a new tool into online instruction
- ❑ Integrate a digital citizenship skills and/or digital literacy skills into class instruction
- ❑ Try a new tool for independent practice, game-based learning, or communication

Examples of Best Practice Goals


Hybrid and Blended Learning




- Start communicating MORE with these students
- Try new tools to help build community online and face to face
- Teach students digital literacy and/or digital citizenship skills
- Train teachers how to integrate a new tool

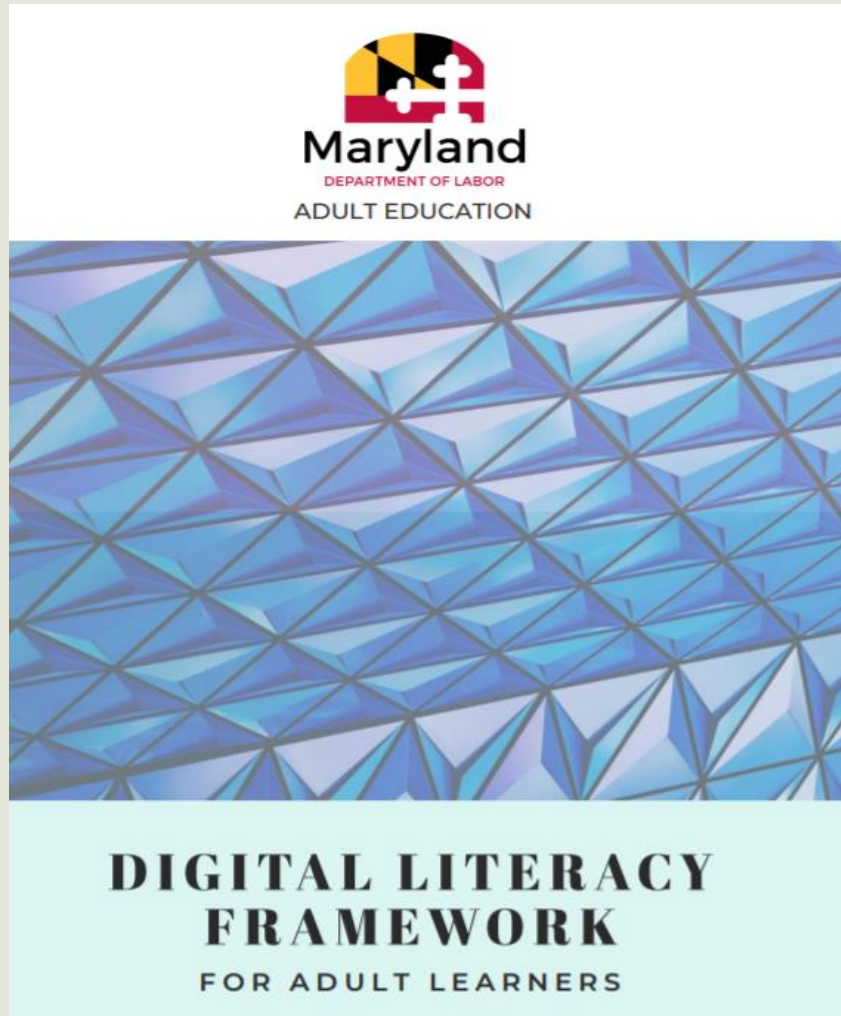
