
### 1. Allow In-State High School Equivalency as Credential/ MSG option

#### Update description:

The Educational Outcomes page was updated to allow a MSG to be added for an Achievement of High School Equivalency for Texas and a credential to be added for High School Equivalency for Texas. Once saved, participant will show on the GED Match report.

NOTE: Previously, both education outcomes could only be added for states other than Texas.

Add the Type 2 High School Equivalency when achieved within the program year (PY) to act as the MSG earned.



### **Business Rules:**


- 1. Allows for an in-state (Texas) HSE to be added manually into TEAMS as both a MSG and a credential
- 2. Data match with TEA with trump any manually entered HSE
- 3. Must have a valid certificate ID number and documented HSE prior to entering into TEAMS
- 4. Must have a profile in the program year for 'date achieved' when entering HSE as a MSG, but profile not required when entering the HSE as a credential only.

#### 2. Added CASAS Assessment Test with Associated Scores

### Update description:

TEAMS has been updated to accept new CASAS scores for all approved CASAS assessments. To enter a CASAS score, follow current procedures for entering assessments in TEAMS under the Participant Record > Assessments.

*Note:* We have not yet removed all the outdated assessments in TEAMS, so the new acceptable CASAS assessments are located at the bottom of the list.



#### **Business Rules:**

1. CASAS assessments (Reading Goals, Math Goals, Life & Work Reading (ESL), Life & Work Listening (ESL)) are all available for use via newly released AEL Assessment Guide policy effective 7/1/19, PY 19-20.

### 3. End Date Added to TABE 9/10 & GAIN


### Update description:

TABE 9/10 & GAIN will no longer be eligible as assessments/test to measure pre/post test gains as of 6/30/2019. Effective 7/1/2019, you will not be able to enter scores or assessments with a date later than 6/30/19. You will have to administer an approved TWC assessment.

TABE 9 & TABE 10 and GAIN will be removed from the drop down menu

After 7/1/2019, you will not be able to select TABE 9, TABE 10 or GAIN in the drop down. You will also not be able to bring forward a TABE 9/10 or GAIN test to be used as a baseline in the new Program Year.


### 4. A Gain Earned is Not Replaced/Lost When New Gain is Entered

#### Update description:

TEAMS MSG's were following the Pre/Post Test page when determining EFL, Type 1a gains, this has been corrected so that once an MSG has been added to the Educational Outcomes screen, subsequent test entries will not remove it. You

could have multiple MSG's as the scores entered are compared against the original baseline test for purposes of measuring the pre/post test gain.


In this example, you can see how TEAMS is capturing the 8/28/18 test, bringing it forward as the baseline. The next test in the PY took place on 11/6/2018, which resulted in a 1 level gain in Total Math.



### Classes

Then, the participant's next test 4/1/2019, they lost gains in Math, but the actual MSG table under Educational Outcome still gives credit for the 11/6/2018 gain.

## 5. Update Potential Match Page with Subsequent Information Received

## Update description:

TEAMS was failing to update subsequent information received through data match with TEA when the information is located on the Potential Match page. Example, a person is placed on the Potential Match page due to taking a TxCHSE content area test (Math) but the Last Name did not match so instead of this being seen by a match in TEAMS to show the Math test that was taken, this person was placed on the Potential Match page. Once on the Potential Match page, subsequent content area test or TxCHSE achievements would not be updated.

Now, if a person is on the potential match for taking a content area test from an approved TxCHSE vendor and then complete the TxCHSE certification, TEAMS will update from the Potential Match with the certificate information.

**Note:** All Potential Matches should be cleared out each week/month by the local Grantee. If you don't submit the acknowledgement that the student was served by you—you will not get credit.

This shows the exported Potential Match page showing that this participant only has a TxCHSE test, as no certificate information is listed.
